District Scorecard Facts

To measure the district's progress on the *Achieve Today. Excel Tomorrow.* strategic plan, the AISD Board of Trustees has approved a district scorecard. This scorecard will promote continuous improvement and accountability for the district and also ensure the district achieves goals targeted in the strategic plan.

The district scorecard is broken down into pillars that can each be applied to different departments in the AISD. Academic achievement, college readiness, leadership, citizenship and responsibility, and workforce readiness will be part of the review process for the scorecard.

Some of the targeted areas for academic achievement include:

- Ensuring all campuses obtain a Met Standard rating.
- Increasing the percentage of K-2 students passing Istation Indicators of Progress for reading from 70 percent to 71 percent.
- Increasing the percentage of K-2 students passing Diagnostic Math Assessment from 80 percent to 81 percent.

Targeted areas for college readiness include:

- Increasing the percentage of 2017 AISD graduates meeting Texas Success Initiative standard from 23 percent to 24 percent.
- Increasing the percentage of 2017 AISD graduates completing the equivalent of six semester credit hours for dual credit, Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate courses from 45 percent to 47 percent.

Leadership, citizenship and responsibility areas that are targeted include:

- Increasing the mean score on the employee engagement survey from 3.69 to 3.72.
- Increasing the mean score on the district services survey from 3.92 to 3.97.
- Increasing the mean score on the student survey of quality instruction from 3.05 to 3.07.
- Increasing the mean score on the student survey of safety from 2.65 to 2.67.
- Maintaining scheduled progress on Phases 1, 2 and 3 bond projects and ensuring overall bond program is within budget.
- Proposing intentional annual budgets to meet the needs of district operations and the strategic plan.

Targeted areas for workforce readiness include:

- Increasing the percentage of all eligible AISD students participating in a CTE coherent sequence of courses from 26 percent to 28 percent.
- Increasing the percentage of all eligible AISD student spassing the related workforce certificate exam from 80 percent to 83 percent.

Implementing the district scorecard is a key part of the *Achieve Today. Excel Tomorrow.* strategic plan that includes being a premier school district and a leader in education.
